



**Statement of Limitation of Practice
Part-Time Solicitor-General**

In accordance with the provision of the Policies of the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") regarding training and access to Council information technology resources, the undersigned certifies as follows:

1. I serve on a part-time basis as the Solicitor-General of the State Court of _____ County, and, by law, I am permitted to engage in the private practice of law;
2. In my private practice, I do not represent defendants in criminal cases or claimants/defendants in forfeiture cases brought by or on behalf of the State of Georgia, or any of its political subdivisions, in the courts of this State.
3. This statement is made for the purpose of qualifying the undersigned as:
 - (a) Eligible to submit claims for reimbursement of expenses incurred while attending Council training programs; and
 - (b) Authorized to access on-line resources of the Council solely for use in the performance of the official duties of my office as counsel for the State of Georgia in the prosecution of criminal cases.
4. If subsequent to the submission of this statement, I intend to represent defendants in criminal cases or claimants/defendants in forfeiture cases in the courts of this State, I am required to notify the Council and that my eligibility and authorization under Para. 3 will be withdrawn.

The information in this statement is true and correct and the undersigned understands that it is subject to the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 16-10-20 and the provisions of Rules 4.1, 8.4(a)(4), and 9.5(a) of the Georgia Code of Professional Conduct.
