Council Personnel

Political Activity

1. Council employees may only seek election to judicial office after first obtaining approval to seek such elective office from the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council. Council approval will be considered on the merits of each individual case as the facts of such case are presented.
2. Council employees may, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 45-10-70, offer for and hold any elective or appointive office of a political subdivision of the state, political party, or political organization; provided, that the office is not full-time, the council determines that it will not conflict with the performance of the employee's official duties, and is not otherwise prohibited by law.
