Training

Mission

The Training Division is responsible for assessing the training needs of all prosecuting attorneys in the State of Georgia and their staff. The Division coordinates and conducts those training programs necessary to provide the prosecutors of the State of Georgia and their staff with training sufficient to equip them with the skills necessary to perform their duties. The Division develops training programs which satisfy the annual continuing legal education (CLE) requirements of the State Bar of Georgia's for attorneys, as well as the annual requirements set by the Peace Officers Standards & Training Council (P.O.S.T.) for investigators employed in prosecutor's offices.

The division co-sponsors education training programs developed by other prosecutor offices in order to assist them in obtaining CLE, P.O.S.T. and other continuing education credits for such training. The Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of Georgia also provides a limited amount of scholarship funding to prosecutors desiring to attend approved out-of-state training programs.
