Training

Scholarships

1. Subject to the availability of funds, the Council will provide scholarship funding to prosecutors desiring to attend approved out-of-state training programs.
2. **Scholarship Funding.** The Council may fund the scholarships authorized by this subsection. The Council shall annually set the amount which may be utilized for scholarship funding.
3. All requests for scholarship funds must be submitted on an application form provided by the Council to the Executive Director who shall have the authority to either grant or deny the request.
4. Individuals receiving scholarship funding must agree to remain a prosecutor for a minimum of three (3) years following the completion of the training program for which they received scholarship funding. Those who leave prosecution prior to the fulfillment of their three (3) year obligation must repay the full amount of the scholarship to the Council, unless the Council waives repayment.
