Trial Support

Mission

The mission of the Trial Support Division is to perform the following assigned duties in an efficient and effective manner:

1. Research, compile and dispense information on trial and appellate issues and evidentiary procedures and foundations to prosecutors and assistant prosecutors at all levels of state prosecution.
2. Research and write memoranda and briefs as instructed by the Council and the Executive Director pursuant to the policies of the Council.
3. Prosecute individual cases as assigned by the Executive Director pursuant to the policies of the Council.
4. Develop and update Trial, Evidence and Forms Manuals for use by prosecutors at all levels of state prosecution.
5. Supervise the PAC summer law school intern program.
6. Supervise and complete special projects, which relate to trial and appellate practice in Georgia, or which have a direct effect on prosecutors and assistant prosecutors within Georgia, as may be assigned by the Council or the Executive Director.
