Trial Support

Intern Program

1. The Executive Director is authorized to collaborate with law schools to place student interns in district attorney's and solicitors-general's offices. Wherever possible, priority will be given to placing interns in rural offices to encourage the students to locate in those areas after graduation from law school.
2. The salary of such interns will be paid by the Council in an amount to be set by the Executive Director.
3. The Council staff will manage the placement of interns hired to work in District Attorney's and Solicitor-General's offices. District Attorneys and Solicitors-General who have identified a law student who is interested in working as an intern in their office should notify the Executive Director.
4. Funds in the Food Stamp Account may be used to compensate law student interns.
